Bachelor of Computer Application (BCA)

Bachelor of Computer Applications (BCA) is an undergraduate degree programme that focuses on computer applications and software development. Duration: 3years (6 Semesters) Full-time Degree Course/4 years (8 Semesters) Full-time Honours Course.

Eligibility: Passed 10+2 or equivalent. (As per University guideline*).

Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA)

BBA stands for Bachelor of Business Administration. It is an undergraduate degree programme that focuses on developing the skills and knowledge necessary for a career in the business and management field. BBA programmes typically cover a broad range of business-related subjects to provide students with a strong foundation in business principles and practices. BBA programme aims to develop a range of skills, including critical thinking, problem-solving, communication, teamwork, leadership, and analytical skills. Graduates of BBA programmes are prepared for entry-level positions in various industries such as finance, marketing, human resources, and management.

Duration: 3years (6 Semesters) Full-time Degree Course/4 years (8 Semesters) Full-time Honours Course.

Eligibility: Passed 10+2 or equivalent. (As per University guideline*).

BBA in Hospital Management (BHM)

A Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA) in Hospital Management is a specialized undergraduate programme designed to provide students with the skills and knowledge needed to manage and administer healthcare organizations effectively. This programme combines business and management principles with a focus on the unique challenges and requirements of the healthcare industry. This programme provides students with a solid foundation in both business and healthcare, preparing them for managerial roles in healthcare organizations. It combines theoretical knowledge with practical experience, equipping graduates to address the unique challenges of the healthcare industry. As the healthcare sector continues to evolve, professionals with a background in hospital management play a pivotal role in ensuring efficient and effective healthcare delivery.

Duration: 3years (6 Semesters) Full-time Degree Course/4 years (8 Semesters) Full-time Honours Course.

Eligibility: Passed 10+2 or equivalent. (As per University guideline*).

Bachelor in Optometry (B. OPTOM)#

Optometry is a healthcare profession that focuses on the examination, diagnosis, treatment, and management of disorders and conditions related to the eyes and vision. Optometrists are trained to provide primary eye care services, including prescribing glasses and contact lenses, detecting and managing eye diseases, and promoting overall eye health. After successful completion of this programme, graduates can work as optometrists in various settings such as private practice, eye care clinics, hospitals, or corporate settings.

Duration: 4 years (8 Semesters) Full-time Honours Course.

Eligibility: Passed 10+2 or equivalent. (As per University guideline*).

BSc in Medical Lab Technology (BMLT)#

Medical Laboratory Technology course typically provides students with the knowledge and skills necessary to work in a medical laboratory setting. This programme aims to train individuals in various aspects of laboratory testing, analysis, and the use of advanced technologies to assist in the diagnosis and treatment of diseases. 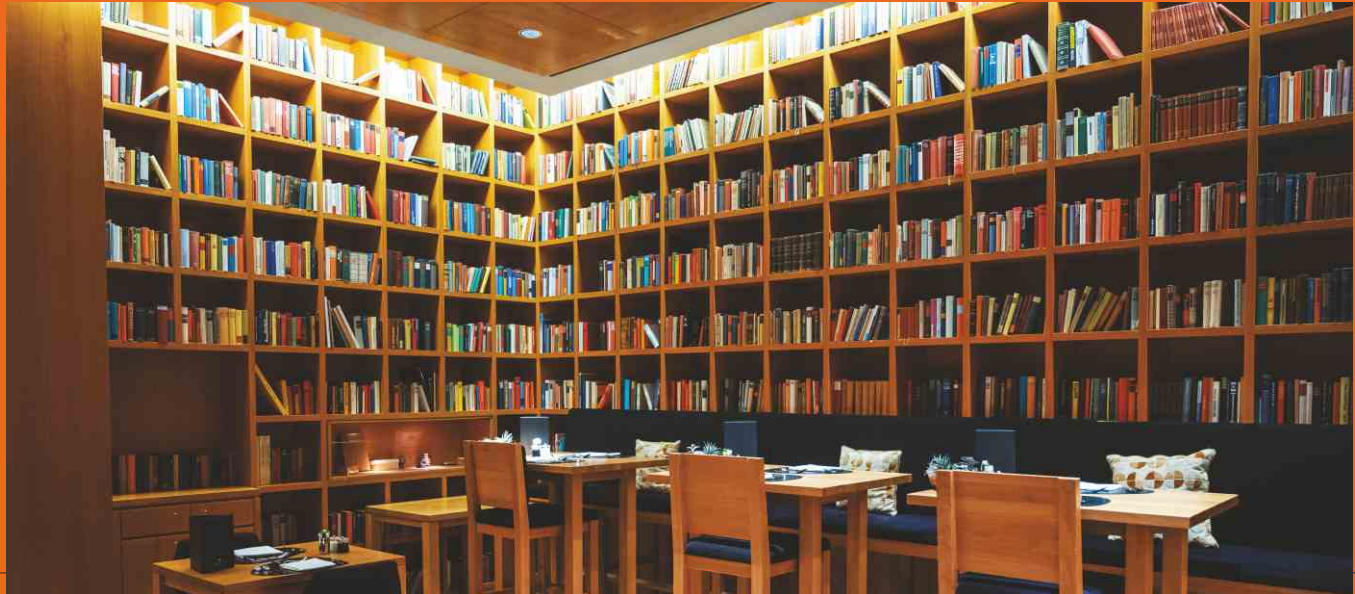
